He/She acts preoccupied or distant. This can be reflected in a number of ways, at times showing signs of guilt or brooding.

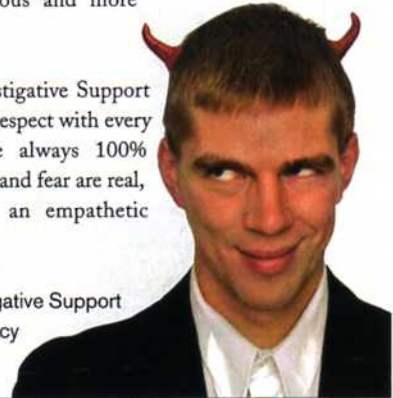
